## FOUR NEW PREFIXES

Scientists have approved the introduction of four new prefixes that can be applied to units of measurement can in the metric system. For the first time in more than three decades, officials have designated brand-new prefixes that can be applied to units of measurement within the metric system. Four new prefixes RONNA, RONTO, and QUETTA & QUECTO will allow scientists to quantify the very largest & smallest things in the universe.

The new prefixes can be applied to any of the seven base units in the metric system: grams for (weights: meters for distance; seconds for time; lamps for electrical current; Kelvin for temperature: moles for amount of substance as well as other units, such as bytes for computing. The new names start in 'r' & 'q' because these were the only letters to not be currently assigned in the metric system.

The main reason for the new prefixes is that data science has advanced so much & there is now much greater need for greater digital storage in Computing, representatives of the U.K.'s National Physics Laboratory who led the push for the new prefixes wrote in a statement.
