BUDGET 2021-22

The Union Budget 2021-2022 was presented by the Honorable finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on 1st February 2021 in the parliament. The Budget speech was given by finance Minister from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. This year Budget lays focus on the six pillars for reviving the economy. Some highlights of Budget 2021-2022 are:

- Our finance Minister starts the Budget 2021 announcement by mentioning the challenges during the pandemic and the vision of the Pradhan Mantri Garbs Kalyan Yojana.
- Finance Minister that India has two COVID-19
 vaccines made available and two more will be
 made accessible soon.
- 3. Finance Minister reiterated that the government is fully prepared to support the economy's reset.
- 4. The scrapping Policy has been announced in the Budget 2021-2022. The voluntary vehicles scrapping policy aims to remove inefficient vehicles. So, as to reduce vehicular pollution and oil import bills.
- Finance Minister proposes an amount of 35000 cores to manufacture and make accessible the COVID-19 vaccine.
- Finance Minister announced that the SEBI will be notified to regulate the setting up and arrangement of the commodity market system.
- The finance Minister proposes to focus on the various allied laws of the securities market to be

merged to the securities market code.

- 8. Finance Minister announces that a new asset reconstruction company is to be set up to provide resolution to stressed assets in PSUs.
- Finance Minister stated that the IPO of LIC will be carried out in FY 2021-2022. Also for the disinvestment strategy, two PSUs and insurance company will be considered.
- 10. The finance Minister announced that agricultural credit will be increased to 16.5 lakh core.
